European Researchers' Night will bring attention to Climate and Environment

The role of research and innovation in the success of the economic, ecological and societal transition will be underlined during the European Researchers' Night 2019 event at Bandabuliya Stage in Nicosia on Friday, 27 September from 19:00 to 21.00. Researchers will share their latest research projects in relation to climate and environment.

European Researchers Night 2019 is an open event where participants will have the opportunity to meet researchers and explore their work relating to climate and environment. At the event, researchers will present their research work in various areas such as sustainable development by reducing carbon emissions and increasing cleaner energy production; climate change and environmental journalism; antimicrobial resistance patterns of three pathogenic bacteria in Mediterranean seawater; and research and social responsibility.

During the event special emphasis will also be given to the importance of research. Researchers will present their work and inform the public about the role and importance of research in climate action and protecting the environment as well as the impact of their research results in sustainable development. At the same time, participants will have the opportunity to engage with the researchers and ask questions. The event will finish with a reception, giving participants and researchers an opportunity to network and share ideas.

European Researchers' Night events are public events dedicated to bringing researchers closer to the public. They showcase the diversity of research and provide the opportunity to meet researchers, talk to them, and find out what they do in a variety of fields. This can be through hands-on experiments, science shows, learning activities for children, guided visits of research labs, science quizzes and more.
