



EU Infopoint says “Walk for Water, Walk for Life”

19 March 2015, NICOSIA: The EU Infopoint aims to raise awareness about water resources with a “Walk for Water, Walk for Life” walking tour to be held on World Water Day, Sunday 22 March from 9:00 am to 13:30 pm. The event welcomes anybody interested in a guided walking tour around water resources through Karavas/Alsancak Village in Cyprus.

The walking tour will be led by a guide who will provide information about water resources, the history of water, water efficiency and EU policies regarding water. Water is a precondition for human, animal and plant life. Water also plays a fundamental role in the climate regulation cycle. The protection of water resources, of fresh and salt water ecosystems and of the water we drink and bathe in is one of the cornerstones of environmental protection in the European Union.

The Water Barometer results indicate that as many as 2 out of 3 EU citizens say that the quality and/or quantity of water is a serious problem. It is a serious problem in the Turkish Cypriot community as well. This event has been organised to provide an opportunity to raise awareness on these issue by exploring water resources in Cyprus.
